Mighty Pine Brewing is a craft brewer in Port Angeles, WA, located on the northern Olympic Peninsula adjacent to Olympic National Park. They brew their own beer on-site, and their tap room features a customer culture where one can enjoy the keystone brewery experience. Mighty Pine Brewing is a destination that cultivates a sense of inclusion and loyalty.

Doug & Amy's Story:

It all started back in 2001 when Amy purchased a home-brewing kit for Doug, and the rest is history. Working as a civil engineering technician at the time, Doug was apt at applying scientific and engineering principles to the construction of public

works projects and used these same skills to improve his home-brewing. Over time, Doug honed his craft and began to accumulate multiple awards when he entered his beer into homebrew competitions. The culmination of these efforts resulted in placing in the Washington Homebrewer's Association's Bert Grant Competition (i.e. Super Bowl of homebrew competitions) twice. Doug placed 1st in 2020, and 2nd in 2017. In addition to being a 20-year award-winning home brewer, he is also a Beer Judge Certification Program (BJCP) beer judge.

With Doug's brewing, engineering, management, and people skills along with Amy's artistic, creative, design, marketing skills and ability for special events planning; the two of them believed they could create a space and brewery that would exceed its customers' expectations. Doug and Amy knew they could create a business model that would be sustainable and profitable. After much research and consideration, they chose Port Angeles and purchased the property at 540 E. 8th St. to pursue their dream of being business owners in the brewing and craft beer industry. The brewery is located at the corner of E. 8th Street and S. Albert Street in Port Angeles.

There is also nostalgia behind their location on Albert Street. Both of their paternal grandfathers were named Albert, and they were also hard-working, successful small business owners.

Elizabeth Rusnak with NWBDA had the pleasure of working with Doug and Amy on their dream of constructing the building that is now the home of Mighty Pine Brewing.
